Recommendations!

Tips and ideas to get the most out of your photographic session

I recommend that you wear very loose clothing, especially underwear and if at all possible, no socks. As these leave indents in the skin and become costly if I have to remove in photoshop. I have robes you can use or you are welcome to bring along your own. Also think about props, I have a wide selection of clothing, lingerie, fabrics and accessories available for you to wear. We have a high standard of hygiene procedures, your health & wellbeing is high importance.

<u>Bra & underwear</u> – Think about your body type and the right underwear will support and uplift the essentials. Push up, strapless, underwire, contour & bralettes. French lace, G string, High wasted & boy shorts.

<u>Babydoll & slips</u> – These are very flattering styles, look great on any body type and especially if you are wanting coverage through the midsection. If you have a fuller bust make sure the baby doll or slips have the support or a bra suits the style.

<u>Bodysuits</u> – Are a one-piece style and also flattering, look great on any body type and especially if you are wanting more coverage. If you have a fuller bust make sure they have the support or a bra suits the style.

<u>Corsets & Bustier</u> – Great to mix and match to create different looks. They cinch the waist but are designed to enhance your bust. Make sure your corset does not flatten the bust.

<u>Robes & Kimonos</u> – kimono or satin/lace robe for your shoot to start out in. You can do so many different looks with them mixing and matching with your other outfits, and have a little more coverage to start.

<u>Non-Traditional clothing</u> – Oversized shirt buttoned down, can be just as beautiful. Anything goes as this is your photographic session.

Suspender belt and stockings or thigh highs, necklaces, or special jewelry. Heels are extremely flattering and sexy.

Think about your hair? You can mix and match and have your hair up or down. Hairstylist & makeup artist available at an additional cost. All this is discussed and finalised at your initial consultation.

The choices are endless!

The most IMPORTANT thing to remember, is bring whatever makes YOU feel good and confident!

CAN I BE NUDE?



Prep Tip or

Moisturize your body before you come to your session. Skip oils & sparkly options. If you wear glasses normally, put in contacts or skip the glasses altogether to avoid glare, unless your glasses are part of your identity and you'd like them to be in your images! Then BRING 'EM!



Shave your legs/underarms and anywhere else you'd like to the night before to avoid razor burn! If waxing, please do so at least 48 hours in advance to minimize pink tones!

Do Not Get a Spray Tan. Not only can your skin tone look uneven but it gets on the furniture/bedding and there will not be specialty editing to make tan lines/colors match.



Wear loose fitting clothes to avoid lines and marks on your body that will show up in pictures. This includes a bra. We recommend wearing a tank top to keep the girls comfortable! Sports bras typically leave marks, please skip that!



Stay hydrated! Drink lots of water in the weeks prior to your session to keep your skin radiant and glowing! Eat a small meal before your session - Do not skip breakfast! That's unhealthy and I promise you wont see a small meal on your tummy!



Stretch the day before your session! Nothing too crazy, you don't want to be too sore at your session! Boudoir posing is a lot of back arching specifically. Your back will likely be sore the next day because you aren't used to these poses or holding them for as long as you will! I will guide you through the poses, so don't stress!

A great stretch is the downward dog and practice arching your back.




Rair & makeup prep

Q: What does the portrait experience cost?

A: I offer 3 main portrait packages – Silver/Gold/Platinum or "A La Carte" option. Please view my website or email me for pricing and a breakdown in the packages. (If you opt for a package, you save a considerably as a bundle deal)

If none of these packages suit your requirements, I also offer a "A La Carte" option, this is where you pay separately for what you choose: session fee, and then you add additional items such as hair & makeup. Legacy printed products are chosen at the reveal session.

Q: What are Legacy Products?

A: Legacy products are professionally designed and printed products to showcase your images. There is nothing more satisfying as a photographer, than seeing the final work professionally framed or displayed in a beautiful album. This can be finalised in the reveal session.

Q: How do I choose my images for my album or framed prints?

A: Approximately after 2 weeks, we book in a reveal session. Reveal Session is when I get to showcase your true beauty. It's an exciting time for both of us. When you get to see your images for the first time in a slide show presentation. This is done either in person or over a virtual meeting. You receive a link also with your slide show.

Q: Do you provide a hair & makeup artist?

A: Depending on the package or if you decide to do "A La Carte" option. I work with a wonderful team of ladies. Carrie is the hairstylist; she creates whatever style we want created to go with the photoshoot and does a fantastic job. Sara is the makeup artist; her work is amazing, and she understands what look and style will work for the client and the photoshoot. This is all part of the experience I want to create for my clients. Hair & makeup artists come to the studio and complete your hair and makeup, so you can enjoy the pampering experience.

Q: Do I get digital images?

A: To me it is important to have professional printed portraits, and these are legacy prints and designed to last a lifetime. My images are my brand, so it is important that I have quality work from the time it was capture in the camera, to being displayed. I do however offer in my platinum package, the digital files of the images chosen to be printed in either the album or folio box.

Q: What will I wear?

A: I have a client wardrobe and in there is a wide selection of lingerie, clothing, jewellery, shoes & props available. These are in a variety of sizes and styles. You are welcome to use these or mix and match with your own wardrobe and jewellery etc. If you are thinking of boudoir styled portrait, I work alongside CocoBella and if a client confirms a booking with me, they receive a discount voucher. (T&C apply)

Q: What do we need to do to prepare and get the best experience from our portrait session?

A:I will send you a "tips and ideas to make the most of your photographic session" PDF on your genre of portrait you have booked. This goes into what you bring along to your consultation and the photoshoot. Also, what to wear on the day of your photoshoot. We will discuss this further in the consultation appointment.



Q: I am not photogenic, and I don't know how to pose?

A: It's okay I've got you covered, I believe everybody is beautiful within the skin they are in, and it is my aim for people especially women to see thier true beauty. And as for the posing I will guide you throughout your session, so all you need to do is have fun on the day and leave the rest up to me. We will also do a mood board, where we can share ideas of the styles that you are interested in and to get inspired for your upcoming photo shoot session.

Q: How Long will the photographic session take?

A: I only book 1 client for the day, so it's all about you today! My studio is warm, comfortable, and private. There is no rush as I don't have a set time frame. I believe taking the photos is only part of the experience when you have a photo shoot with me. I offer refreshments and nibbles and we can take a break as often as needed.

Q: What do I need to do to book a portrait sitting with you?

A: I can be contacted via email, phone, text and I also have a booking system on my website Booking system: https://www.twistedwillowstudio.nz/book-online

Q: Do you have payment plans?

A: Yes, I do have payment plans available. AfterPay is available through my website purchases only. https://www.twistedwillowstudio.nz/shop. If you require help, just message me and I can go through this for you. I also offer a payment plan. T&C Apply

Q: Can I do my portrait in studio or on location?

A:I cater for clients who wish to have their portrait session either in the studio or on location. Please note that on location has additional charges.

Q: What genres of portraits do you photograph?

A: My specialty is Boudoir, maternity, and stylized portraits of woman. I also photograph all of genre portrait styles including corporate portraits and headshots.

Q: Do you do "Sneak Peeks" of my images on social media as I am a private person?

A: I do not do sneak peaks on social media, as your photoshoot was designed personally for you, and you will be there first to see your images. Your privacy is my upmost important to me and I will only use your images with written permission. This is covered during consultation and in your reveal session.

Q: Will you use my images to promote your business?

A: Only if you give me written permission. I am always looking to update my portfolio and love showcasing my work, but I fully understand if you would prefer not to release any images, as these are your personal images and I respect your privacy. If you are happy for me to showcase only a selection of images, you complete a restricted release form. This way we both know what images are available to showcase.
